I am pleased to share some exciting news about our students' academic progress this school year. Since implementing the i-Ready Reading and Math programs at the beginning of the school year, we have seen strong evidence of both academic growth and student success across all grade levels.

Through i-Ready Math's personalized instruction, 34% of our students in Kindergarten through Grade 8 have already demonstrated at least one full year of academic growth, even though we are only at the halfway point of the school year. This progress reflects our students' hard work and the impact of instruction tailored to meet each learner's individual needs.

In i-Ready Reading/Literacy, we are also seeing impressive results. 38% of our students have demonstrated one full year of reading growth in just one semester of school. These gains highlight the effectiveness of focused literacy instruction and consistent student engagement.

Given the strong results we have seen in Math, we are hopeful to purchase i-Ready Reading Personalized Instruction for the upcoming school year. Additionally, our use of CKLA has been a valuable tool in strengthening students' reading and literacy skills, and we will continue using it to support ongoing academic growth.

We are proud of our students' dedication and grateful for the continued support of our teachers and families. Together, we remain committed to ensuring that every student continues to grow, achieve, and reach their full potential.

Thank you for your partnership and support as we celebrate these academic successes and work toward even greater growth for all students.

Private School Tuition Tax Deduction

For taxable years beginning on or after January 1, 2014, a subtraction from income is allowed for the amount paid to send your dependent child to an eligible private school. The subtraction is limited to \$4,000 for tuition paid for an elementary pupil and \$10,000 for a secondary pupil. **Note:** The subtraction is not allowed for amounts paid for private school tuition which were withdrawn from an Edvest or Tomorrow's Scholar college savings account.

Amounts paid to private schools for pre-kindergarten (K3 or K4) are not eligible for the private school tuition subtraction.
