- 3. An essay reflecting on how you embody the spirit of this scholarship. You may write about your family values, your commitment to serving others, your career goals in a helping profession, and/or your involvement in community service. Responses should be typed and limited to 500 words or less.
- 4. Two letters of recommendation
 - a. One from a teacher/professor who can attest to your academic performance and commitment to pursuing a career in a "helping profession."
 - b. One from a community member or family friend who can affirm your character qualities and describe your commitment to serve your family and your community.
- **5.** After being selected for this scholarship, you will be required to submit Verification of Enrollment from your institution to receive the scholarship award.
